The event occurred on 12/12/2019 at approximately 15:47 at THE HEIGHTS CENTER, 333 HAWAII AVENUE NE, WASHINGTON, DC 20011

The events occurred on 12/12/2019 at approximately 1547hrs at 333 Hawaii Avenue Northeast D.C. Washington D.C. in PSA 405.

I Officer Norfleet was working in full uniform in a marked MPD scout car P405 utilizing call sign 4063E when I responded to 333 Hawaii Avenue to assist officers in distress.

An unknown Suspect later identified as D-1 (Pollard, Delvin) fired multiple rounds of ammunition at Fourth District Patrol Officers Isoldi and Dietz while they were entering their parked marked cruiser which was parked in a parking lot located at 333 Hawaii Avenue NE, in Washington, D.C. Neither of the Officers were struck, however a bullet fragment was located in the front bumper of their cruiser and another bullet fragment was lodged between the tire and wheel of the front driver side of their cruiser.

D-1 was standing in a wooded area near the south side of the parking lot and fled traveling westbound on Taylor St NE. The Officers gave chase and requested backup and multiple Fourth District units assisted in canvassing for the D-1. At times during the chase officers lost sight of the D-1, and at the time of his apprehension in the 200 block of Hawaii Ave NE he was unarmed. Officers canvassed the flight path of the D-1 and located an AR-style pistol with a short barrel and no stock inside the a black suitcase in the rear of 216 Varnum St NE. The weapon had no make, model, or serial numbers. The weapon had an extended magazine with 6 rounds of .223 ammunition in the magazine and one round of .223 ammunition in the chamber. At the time of the recovery the firearm appeared to be fully functional, was designed to expel a projectile by means of explosion, was capable of being fired by use of a single hand . A Witness also alerted officers to a black suitcase in the rear of 216 Varnum St NE, where the Witness had observed the D-1.

Officer Isoldi advised that D-1 was a black male, approximately 18-25 years old wearing all black clothing. He stated that he would be able to recognize D-1 if he saw him again therefore Detectives conducted a show-up with the person that Officer Orellana stopped in the 200 block of Hawaii Avenue NE.

At 1631hrs, a show up was conducted and Officer Isoldi positively identified Delvin Pollard as the person who aimed the rifle at the officers and fired shots. Officer Isoldi stated "Yeah, I even recognize the facial hair." Officer Isoldi then asked "Does he have a hood?" Detective Bridgett asked Officer Kearney to turn the person around. Once D-1 turned around Officer Isoldi stated "Yeah."

The D-1 was placed under arrest for AWIK, UF/UA, APO While Armed, Destruction of property, CWPL, Felon in Possession, National Firearm act and Unlawful Discharge Of A Firearm and transported to the Fourth District Station. Once D-1 was fingerprinted , he was identified as Delvin Pollard with DOB: 10-27-94 and PDID 658-353.

A check of law enforcement databases shows that Pollard was previously convicted of a felony punishable by more than one year in jail 01/24/2018 (Docket 2017CF2001780) for "Carrying a Pistol Without a License" involving a handgun with an obliterated serial. As a convicted felon, Pollard is prohibited from lawfully possessing a firearm.

CSU 54 responded and processed the scene.

The event and acts described above occurred primarily in the District of Columbia and were committed as described by defendant(s) listed in the case caption.
