Supplemental investigation required to follow up with the victim to obtain a medical records release form.

Follow up will also be needed to determine if Jaquan is a convicted felon in the juvenile court system.

SUMMARY:

On 10/19/2023, I was dispatched to a shots fired call at Pettibone park. I made contact with the victim Trayvon Hurt, who was shot in the abdomen one time. After investigation, Jaquan McKinney was arrested for the above-listed charges. Jaquan was transported to the La Crosse County Jail. See Investigator Tolvstad and other officers' supplemental reports for more information.

NARRATIVE:

INITIAL CALL:

On 10/19/2023, I was dispatched to Gundersen Health System in La Crosse for a gunshot victim that was dropped off at the emergency room. The narrative stated that the victim was shot in the lower back and that security was with the people who dropped him off. I responded to the scene.

ARRIVAL ON SCENE/CONTACT WITH JAQUAN MCKINNEY:

I arrived on scene to Gundersen Health System. I observed a white SUV parked out front with Wisconsin plate APC-9812. I observed security standing by the vehicle. There were also three females and another male who I recognized from prior contacts as Jaquan McKinney. Jaquan approached me. I verbally identified Jaquan. I asked Jaquan who got shot. Jaquan stated, "I am assuming he got shot." Jaquan stated the person's name was Tray. Another female identified as Kira approached me and stated that they found the male laying on the

ground at Pettibone. Kira stated that it looked like he got shot by the way he was laying. Other officers arrived on scene and I had pulled Jaquan away from everyone else and conducted a brief interview with him.

I noted that Jaquan was wearing jeans, a tan shirt, and a black beanie hat. I also noted that Jaquan had one of his front teeth missing. Jaquan then stated that he had just gotten picked up and he didn't really know what happened.

I asked Jaquan if he knew the guy who had been shot. Jaquan stated that he didn't know him and literally just met him today. Jaquan stated that he had come over to help. Jaquan stated that he had just seen him on the floor. I asked where at Pettibone this occurred. Jaquan shrugged his shoulders and stated, "They seen him." Jaquan stated that he was just helping. I asked him if he picked the person up at Pettibone. Jaquan stated that he didn't pick him up and that "they picked him up." I asked Jaquan if they picked him up after. He stated, "Yeah." Jaquan stated that they picked him up "by the blue bridge."

I asked Jaquan if the male said anything after they picked him up. Jaquan stated, "He didn't say shit." I asked Jaquan if he was in pain. Jaquan stated, "No, he didn't feel nothing." Jaquan stated it didn't even look like the male was in pain and that he was sitting up. Jaquan stated that he did not see any blood on the male.

Jaquan stated the male said he was trying to see where he was bleeding from. Jaquan stated he began helping the male to the door and pointed at the hospital door. Jaquan stated the male then fell. Jaquan told the male then fell. Jaquan told the male that he needed to get help.

I asked Jaquan if the male said he got shot. Jaquan stated that he didn't say that, but he assumed that he got shot.

I concluded my interview with Jaquan and went into the emergency room.

CONTACT WITH MEDICAL STAFF:

I made contact with medical staff who stated that the victim had one gunshot wound. They stated they did not find an exit wound at that time. The wound was to the male's lower right side/abdomen area. The victim was conscious and expected to recover.

VICTIM:

The victim was identified as Trayvon Hurt.

CONTACT WITH TRAYVON HURT:

I remained outside while Trayvon [REDACTED] 146.82(1) Trayvon was then brought back to the emergency room where he was in stable condition. I then interviewed Trayvon. I introduced myself as a police officer to Trayvon and asked him what had happened.

I asked Trayvon if he remembered what happened. He initially stated that he didn't. I asked Trayvon where he was. Trayvon stated, "I think we were in the car." He then stated, "I think my friend was taking apart his gun."

I asked Trayvon who his friend was. He stated he didn't know him. He stated, "I was with Kira Randall and I don't know the kid."

I established that Trayvon was sitting in the front seat of the vehicle. Trayvon stated that Kira was the driver. Trayvon knew [REDACTED] 48.396(1) that was in the car. Trayvon stated that there were a total of six other people in the car not including himself. Trayvon stated there were three people in the third row, two people in the middle row, and then the driver and himself.

I asked Trayvon if a shot just rang out. Trayvon acknowledged that it did. Trayvon said the male started freaking out. Trayvon stated the male stated, "I took the clip out. I didn't, I cocked it back. It must have been jammed or something in there."

I asked Trayvon where the person was that shot. He stated he was seated in the seat directly behind him. Trayvon stated the bullet went through the seat before striking him.

I confirmed that Trayvon was not beefing with anyone. Trayvon stated no indicating he did not have any animosity with anyone. Trayvon stated he didn't know the name of the person that shot him. Trayvon described the male that shot him was a smaller black male that was wearing a black hoodie. The male also had a "bonnet" on. Trayvon also described it as a shower cap. I asked Trayvon if there was anything else he noticed about the male. He stated the male had a missing tooth in front. Trayvon maintained multiple times that he did not know a name or nickname for the person that shot him.

I asked Trayvon where they were at when the shooting happened. He stated "across the bridge." Trayvon said that they were driving. I asked Trayvon if someone had a gun out in the car. He stated yes. He said that the person was taking the gun apart. He stated that he did see the gun. He stated that it was a "Ghost gun" (meaning unserialized and untraceable firearm that can be bought online and assembled at home according to ATF). I asked him how he knew it was a Ghost gun and he stated the male was talking about it. He stated that it looked like a Glock pistol.

I asked Trayvon if he thought the shooting was intentional. He stated, "No, dude." Trayvon stated that the shooter stated, "Please tell me you're all right" and was trying to help him out.

I asked clarifying questions about when the shooting had happened. Trayvon stated that he wasn't looking back when it happened. I asked him if the male was taking the gun apart. I asked Trayvon if he knew why the male was taking the gun apart. He stated yes. I asked why. Trayvon stated, "He shot twice when we were at Pettibone." He stated the male shot in the air and then they left. The male was then taking the gun apart. Trayvon stated that they were in the parking lot by the beach at Pettibone.

Trayvon stated after the shot was fired and he was struck, they drove directly to the hospital.

Trayvon stated that he did not want to pursue charges against the person that shot him.

Trayvon was then taken to [REDACTED] 146.82(1) for his bullet wound.

ARREST OF JAQUAN MCKINNEY:

Based on the description provided by Trayvon and Jaquan being with the vehicle at the hospital, I informed Sergeant Mandujano over the police radio that Jaquan McKinney would likely be the suspect. Jaquan was eventually detained by Sergeant Mandujano and transported to City Hall for an interview by Officer Carroll.

SECOND CONSENT SEARCH OF VEHICLE:

After my interview was concluded, I met with Sergeant Hughes and Mandujano and related my findings. Sergeant Hughes then obtained consent from the vehicle driver to search the vehicle once again. Officer Morris, Sergeant Hughes, and I conducted a consent search of the vehicle. I located a bullet entrance and exit wound in the front passenger seat of the vehicle as well as blood on the passenger seat. I photographed the entrance and exit holes.

I searched the trunk area and the storage compartment of the trunk area. I located a yellow fanny pack. Inside of the fanny pack was a Glock style handgun with no writing or serial number on it. There was also a large amount of ammunition in the fanny pack.

Next to the yellow fanny pack was a black sweatshirt.

I put on a fresh pair of gloves and took the firearm out of the fanny pack. I attempted to make the firearm safe. When I slid the slide back, there was an empty shell casing in the chamber. The empty shell casing was taken out and placed in an evidence envelope.

The sweatshirt and fanny pack and casing were secured in my squad car.

EVIDENCE:

I transported the evidence to the City of La Crosse Police Department. I photographed and packaged the black sweatshirt located in the trunk of the vehicle. The rest evidence was turned over to Sergeant Hansen and Investigator Tolvstad for processing. See their reports for more information.

The gun was a "Ghost" gun with no serial number. The handle of the gun had P80 written on it. Other than that, there was no serial number or markings on the gun. The gun was a 9mm.

ARREST OF JAQUAN MCKINNEY/JAIL:

Investigator Tolvstad and Mancuso conducted an interview with Jaquan McKinney. They informed me that Jaquan admitted to shooting two rounds at Pettibone Park then accidentally shooting Trayvon in the vehicle. See Investigator Tolvstad's report for more information. Sergeant Hansen requested that I transport Jaquan to the La Crosse County Jail for the above-listed charges.

Investigator Tolvstad informed Jaquan that he would be taken into custody. Jaquan placed his hands behind his back. I placed Jaquan in one set of handcuffs. I checked the cuffs for fit and safety locked them. I searched Jaquan. I then escorted Jaquan to my squad car and placed him in the backseat.

I transported Jaquan to the La Crosse County Jail. He was turned over to jail staff without incident.

RECORD CHECK OF JAQUAN:

Dispatch advised that Jaquan was on one felony and one misdemeanor bond at the time of this incident. Both bonds indicate a condition that the defendant shall not commit any crime. Jaquan does not have a CCW permit.

Dispatch advised Jaquan is not a convicted felon, however further investigation will need to be done to examine his juvenile criminal record for any felony convictions.

It should be noted, jail staff advised Jaquan does not have a middle name. However, his DOT return and his name in the bond system has "L" for his middle initial.

COMPLETION OF EVIDENCE:

I returned to the City of La Crosse Police Department. Sergeant Hansen had all the evidence packaged and turned it over to me. I then secured the evidence in evidence locker #24. The following items were logged into evidence by me. Other officers also logged separate evidence for this case.

- Item 009: Black Glock-style 9mm "Ghost" gun with no serial number
- Item 010: One spent 9mm shell casing located in the firearm
- Item 011: Glock magazine and nine 9mm rounds
- Item 012: 51 loose 9mm rounds which were located in yellow fanny pack
- Item 013: Yellow fanny pack saddle bag which contained firearm and ammunition
- Item 014: DNA swabs taken from Jaquan McKinney by Investigator Tolvstad
- Item 015: Black sweatshirt located in the trunk of vehicle next to fanny pack

FIREARM TRACE FORM:

A firearm trace form was completed and turned in.

MEDICAL RELEASE FORM:

At this time, a medical release form has not been obtained for the victim. Follow up will be needed to complete that.

DISPOSITION:

On 10/19/2023, officers were dispatched to a shots fired call. The victim Trayvon Hurt was shot while riding in a vehicle. After investigation, Jaquan McKinney was arrested and jailed for the above-listed charges. Further follow up may be needed. See other officers' reports for more information.
