Impact of Fort Lauderdale Airport Shooting

15) Some people say that the shooting at the Fort Lauderdale airport happened because Florida airports are gun-free zones, where law-abiding gun owners cannot openly or concealed carry a gun, and that if the airport was not a gun-free zone, fewer people would have been killed in the tragic shooting because there would have been more people lawfully armed with guns to have stopped the lone gunman.

Others say that the Fort Lauderdale shooting is exactly the reason why airports should remain gun-free zones, and that the issue is not whether more people have guns there but how law enforcement is deployed. All that would have occurred with more people carrying guns in the airport would have been more chaos and potentially more harm.
